Congratulations! I am Proud of You!

On Saturday, August 15, the delegates of the South Georgia Annual Conference approved our desire to separate from the denomination. The majority of delegates realized that in good conscience, the members of Asbury Memorial could no longer tolerate the discrimination against LGBTQ people within the United Methodist Church. For 27 years, the members of Asbury Memorial tried to work for justice and change within the denomination. We were hopeful that change would finally occur at the 2019 General Conference. Realizing that this could be a historic event, many Asburians traveled to St. Louis to attend the Conference, including Lance Wilhelm, who leads our Reconciling Ministries.

The General Conference, however, was a major disappointment. When the majority of delegates voted to maintain the discriminatory position, we had to take action. A church vote was held with 316 Asbury members participating. It was almost a unanimous decision to leave the denomination. There would be many steps we would need to take for this goal to occur. One of the last steps was getting on the agenda of the South Georgia Annual Conference. Due to the pandemic, we weren't even sure there would be an Annual Conference this year.

However, thanks to technology, the Annual Conference was held virtually, and its "business session" was on August 15. Around 2:20 PM, the delegates voted to accept our disaffiliation. *I think we're the only church in the state of Georgia to take these steps in our denomination for the purpose of being inclusive to all people. I am mighty proud of the people of Asbury Memorial!*

There still is some work to be done. We have to exchange some documents with the South Georgia Conference, and we have to make our payment for the property. We believe this will all be completed by September 1st!

SEPTEMBER WILL BE A GREAT MONTH OF CELEBRATION!!!

Each Sunday in the month, we will be celebrating this new phase in our lives.

We will begin on September 6th by having our first Holy Communion together as the church family of Asbury Memorial Church. Also, Janet Wagner will be addressing the congregation. Janet is the chair of our Church Council and has done a masterful job of leading us through the disaffiliation process. And we'll be having our first ever virtual New Member Class join the church.

On September 13th, we will consecrate the "new church" and hear from some leaders in our community about this step we have taken.

On September 20th, we will recognize our "Elderberries" – the members of the church who refused to close the doors in 1993 when they were told Asbury had no future. Speaking of future, on this same Sunday, we will be highlighting our children and youth ministries.

And then finally, on September 27th, we will be recognizing all of the couples who could not be married in their church sanctuary. This will be a very special virtual experience. You better have some tissues on hand!

What an incredible month it will be! And then there's God On Broadway in October! That's going to be cool, too. But let's focus on September first. After all, we have a lot to celebrate and much to be thankful to God for!

Spread the news! All are now TRULY welcomed and included at Asbury Memorial!

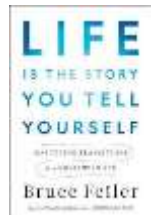

Cardio, strength training (light weights or bodyweight), stretching and more will help with your goals.

Voting Information

It's not too soon to begin planning for election day on November 3, 2020

Since many of you are still sheltering in place or minimizing your trips into the outside world we are recommending you take advantage of your right to vote by Absentee Ballot. Here's some Information to help your election participation go smoothly.

The key to making sure your absentee vote counts is to

REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT NOW

FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

MAIL YOUR BALLOT IN NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 20TH or

DROP IT OFF IN PERSON USING THE BIG BLUE DROP BOX (Chatham County)

With the slowdown in service at the US Post Office mail time will be delayed. All Savannah mail goes to Jacksonville, FL processing center first. So mail your ballot at least 2 full weeks to reach the elections office.

An alternative to mail-in is drop-off. It is quick and secure for Chatham County residents to drop their ballots off at the Chatham County Board of Election's Office.

If you are going to vote in person, please check My Voter Page on election day to verify your polling place. Consider early voting to avoid long lines on election day.

In Georgia My Voter Page <https://www.mvp.sos.ga.gov/MVP/mvp.do> is your resource through the entire voting process.

In South Carolina SC Votes <https://scvotes.gov/> has all your information.

Key Dates in Georgia:

September 15, 2020	Earliest day to begin mail-in voting
October 5, 2020	Last day to register for to vote
October 12, 2020	Early in person voting begins
October 24, 2020	Saturday in person voting
November 3, 2020	Election Day

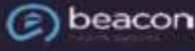
